A. Discussion for Amendment

BEDH Public Participation at School Committee Meetings

This policy was discussed and some grammatical errors were corrected. Some highlighted additions to the policy consist of:

Guidelines from the state and federal free speech laws

All remarks are respectful and addressed through the Chair of the Meeting

Comments must concern the educational goals, policies, budget, or performance of the Superintendent.

Public Participation will be known as Public Speak

The Policy Sub Committee will recommend these amendments to the Revere School Committee at the next scheduled meeting.

JFABD Homeless Students: Enrollment Rights and Services

This policy was discussed and some grammatical errors were corrected. Some recommendations were made:

Transportation will last until the end of the school year, in which a student is permanently housed

Preschool students can remain where they attended after they become permanently housed

Preschool students have the right to receive transportation

These amendments would comply with Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015 (ESSA)

The Policy Sub Committee will recommend these amendments to the Revere School Committee at the next schedule meeting.

B. Discussion for Adoption

KHAA Distribution of Literature and Info in the Schools

This policy will be a new policy for Revere Public Schools. This policy would detail the following:

The School Committee does not endorse or sponsor agencies

Disclaimer

Superintendent's approval and timeline

Translation in languages used by Revere Public Schools

Programs and events held within the City of Revere

E-flyers will be an alternative to distribution of paper flyers
